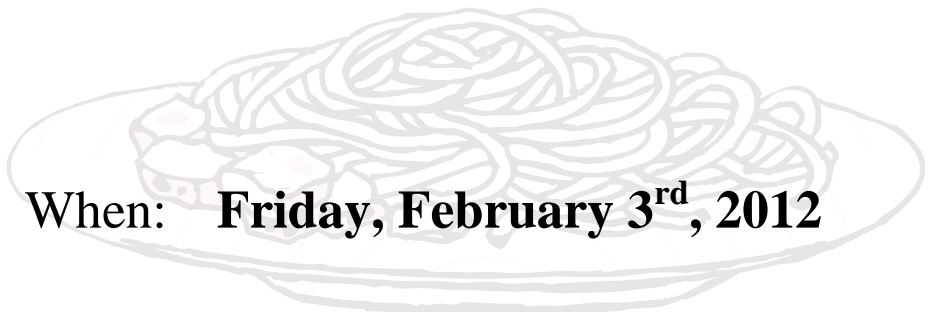
St. James' Congregational Council will meet Thursday, Feb. 2 at 7:30 p.m.
